Dues must be paid in full with application.

Dues paid to the Chamber are not a charitable tax deduction for Federal Income Tax purposes. The Chamber is not a charity but serves as an advocate organization for businesses.

The 1994 Federal Budget Act has eliminated the tax deductibility of that portion of dues used for lobbying purposes. The Chamber board has estimated that 6% of your dues will be used for lobbying purposes. This means that the remaining 94% may be deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense.

SUPPLEMENTAL DUES INVESTMENT SCHEDULE

REAL ESTATE and INSURANCE OFFICES

These firms are assessed using the regular investment schedule based on employment, and licensed salespeople are considered employees. (Ex: An office with a broker/owner, secretary, and 10 employees would have 12 employees and be assessed accordingly.)

PROFESSIONALS

Investment is determined at \$207 for the first professional associate with the firm or practice, and \$75 for each additional professional. (This category includes medical doctors, veterinarians, CPAs, attorneys, psychologists, optometrists, etc.)

TAX-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS/ NON-PROFITS

Annual dues investment is \$207 or 50% of the investment based upon employment, whichever is greater.

SMALL ENTREPRENEUR INCENTIVE

Business owners having a membership in the Chamber at a regular investment rate may enroll additional businesses, which they own, at a discounted rate, providing the additional business employs fewer than 4 people. The discounted rate shall be \$95, and is payable in full annually.

SPECIAL ACCOUNTS

The President has the authority to negotiate investment amounts for those firms which are not physically located in the area, but wish to maintain a membership.
