Each participant is required to attend orientation on August 16, 2023, 3:30 – 5:30 PM, a full-day seminar once a month, on the third Thursday of each month from September through May, unless otherwise notified. If you are unable to make such a commitment, it is suggested that you not apply at this time. As a matter of policy, attendance at all sessions is required. Leadership Central Penn recognizes, however, unanticipated circumstances at home and/or at work could require absence from a session. More than one absence from all or part of a session, however, will jeopardize successful completion of the program.
