Berwick, PA – **Community Giving Foundation** is honored to build and manage a permanent endowment in the Central Susquehanna region, ensuring that resources are available to meet local needs both today and for generations to come. The Foundation is pleased to announce **grant awards totaling \$68,000** to nonprofit and government agencies through the C.K. Battram Fund's 2026 competitive process. Grants were selected by a committee of Foundation staff and community members, guided by the philosophy of the late C.K. Battram and the following six pillars: broadcast evangelism; college labor; home health and hospice care; clinical and hospital facilities; social services to the poor; and community development.
