Sponsler Park Shines with New Accessible Upgrades: Ribbon Cutting & Community Celebration Set for Nov. 8

BERWICK, PA – The Borough of Berwick, in partnership with the Columbia/Montour Chamber of Commerce, will hold a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for Sponsler Park on Saturday, November 8, from 12:00–2:00 PM. The celebration marks the completion of major improvements to the West End neighborhood park.

The family-friendly event will include live music from Dan Hess, a food truck, and a coffee truck serving hot and cold beverages. Local nonprofits, including Jeremy's Journey, Berwick Arts Association, Berwick Theater and Center for Community Arts, and For the Cause (operator of the Berwick Teen Center), will also participate. Youth from Berwick Teen Center's Youth Action Board will hand out free hotdogs and popcorn while supplies last.

Borough-Led Park Improvements

The Borough of Berwick, through the leadership of its Department of Public Works (DPW), managed and constructed the upgrades at Sponsler Park. The project was primarily funded through the federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, administered by the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development, with additional support from the Community Giving Foundation and the Berwick Youth in Philanthropy group.

The enhancements include:

- New electrical service and lighting
- A stage and pavilion for concerts and events
- Accessible play equipment for children of all abilities
- A resurfaced basketball court
- Continuous sidewalks totaling two-tenths of a mile, creating safe walking loops

"This project was about creating a safe, welcoming space where families, neighbors, and groups can gather year-round," said Jack Kyttle, Public Works Foreman. "From the new play equipment to the improved basketball court and pavilion, our team worked hard to give the community a park they can be proud of. It has been rewarding to see Sponsler Park transform into such a vibrant space. The DPW team's dedication and teamwork continue to make a real difference in our community, and I'm proud to recognize their efforts."

For Teresa Peters, the Borough's Finance Assistant, the project carries special meaning. "I grew up on Monroe Street and played at Sponsler Park all the time," Peters said. "The park was always filled with kids, and I'll never forget the Easter Egg Hunts the Giuseppe Garibaldi Society of West Berwick used to host. Seeing it now, with accessible upgrades for a new generation, is really special."
