<u>Updates on Projects in the Town of Bloomsburg:</u>

Ongoing Projects Around Town:

- **Pollinator Fields** Recently cut back per Conservation District guidance. Public Works completed the work in-house with the boom mower.
- **Boat Launches** The Town-owned boat launch at the confluence of the Susquehanna River and Fishing Creek is now open! Reminder: Town has **two launches**—one stateowned on Airport Road and the other Town-owned at the confluence.
- **Pickleball Courts** The base is curing; weather permitting, the contractor will return mid-September to continue progress.
- **Solar Project** Bids for rooftop solar installations at Public Works and Recycling are pending review at the next Council meeting.
- Market Street Paving Contractor will be awarded on September 11th at a special Town Council meeting. Work will be completed this fall.
- Airport Projects New concrete step and rail work began today. The jet fuel tank removal has been awarded to the third-lowest quote (\$6,000) to ensure proper DEP reporting.
- Recreation Projects Tennis courts, basketball courts, and the skatepark paving project will go out to bid this fall, with work scheduled for Spring 2026.
